Theme	Colours In this topic, the students will learn all about colours and how colours are used in art. Through creative projects, the students will identify different colours, and how colours mix to create new colours. They will relate colours to different environments, themselves, and emotions.	Me and My Body In this topic, children will learn about their bodies and what makes them unique. They will be able to name body parts, talk about their senses, and discover how their bodies help them every day. Children will make self-portraits, explore movement and healthy choices.	People who help us In this topic, children will find out about the different people who help us at home, in school, and in the community. They will learn about important jobs and how helpers keep us safe and cared for. They will role-play as helpers and design and create their own tools.	Animals In this topic, children will learn about a variety of different animals through stories. They will be able to identify and name different animals as well as talk about some of their features. Through creative projects children will create their own representations of animals.	Caring for our planet In this topic, children will learn how to look after the world around them. They will talk about nature, recycling, and the importance of caring for plants, animals, and the Earth. Children will plant seeds, design posters and take part in activities that show how we can protect our planet.	Into Space In this topic, the students will learn about the world beyond earth and explore outer space. They will learn about the different planets, suns, moons, and stars, looking at their similarities and differences. The children will have the opportunity to explore space travel through role-play, construction, and junk modelling.	Under the sea In this block, the children will be learning all about different bodies of water, the animals that live in there and how to care for this environment. The children will learn the names of animals and their babies and how they survive under the water. They will also look at staying safe near and in water. In some fun science experiments, the class will learn how items float or sink.
