



## Curriculum Plans - Year 11 - Art & Design - Academic Year 2023/24

Please find below a detailed outline of the curriculum covered in Art and Design through Year 11 in key stage 4. Students will work through two components: Component 1: Portfolio and Component 2: Externally Set Assignment.

They will explore a range of artists, techniques, and styles to develop their practical skills in accordance with the AQA GCSE Assessment Objectives, whilst having greater independence and ownership of their work.
