This activity encourages critical thinking and helps students develop persuasive argumentation skills.</p>	<p>Poster Campaign: Assign groups of students to create posters in Slovene promoting messages of gender equality, disability inclusion, or reducing inequalities. They can display these posters around the school to raise awareness.</p>	<p>Infographic Design: Challenge students to create infographics in Slovene that visually represent data and facts related to economic growth, industry trends, or sustainable communities.
